#### Step 7

Arrive in Romania, start your academic journey & take care of formalities

Under 90 days, you must report to the immigration services for the registration to obtain the residence

In order to obtain the residence card, a file must be prepared and consists of:

- 1) Application / Travel documents/ photos / entry visa in Romania (for those who need it)
- 2) The letter issued by the university and to the Director of the Immigration Police
- 3) The rental agreement / lease (covering the entire period of the current year of study) / notaries declaration (the case of residence in a host family)
- 4) Financial guarantees for one year: bank statement (minimum 2,000 Euros) or equivalent.
  - 5) Medical certificate
  - 6) Insurance Payment Proof (for students aged 26 and over)
- 7) Proof of payment of the residence card tax



Step 3

Contact the university of choice and apply for your desired study program

The university will ask for your documents.
Some universities will provide you with the
possibility to register online, but others will ask for
the documents in hard copy.
Send / upload the required documents.
Pay the application fee - if needed.

Step 4

Wait for feedback and/or the Acceptance Letter

The university will review your documents and will facilitate the recognition process for your prior degrees.

Some universities will require an online or face-to-face interview or even passing an examination to be admitted (check the details for the specific program you are interested in).

Each university will submit the application file for admission to studies in Romania to the Ministry of Education (the minimum period of processing the application is 30 days, up to 60 days). If a positive decision is reached by the Ministry, a "Letter of Acceptance" is issued and sent to the university and by case at the diplomatic mission.

Should the institution you've applied for, cannot honor your request, the Ministry of Education can suggest another university according to your profile, preferences and availabilities at the moment.

Romania has 46 public universities, 7 military universities and 29 private universities (2022).

Most of them offer the full cycle of studies consisting of:

#### 1st cycle (Bachelor)

3 or 4 years, 180 - 240 ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System)

> 2nd cycle (Master's) 1 or 2 years, 60 - 120 ECTS

3rd cycle (PhD)

minimum of 3 years full time, 240 ECTS

#### GOSTS

Romania is one of the least-expensive countries in the EU. It has prices for every pocket.

#### PRIVATE ACCOMMODATIONS

Range from 150 euros per month per person to over 500 for a whole, multi-bedroom flat.

#### A DRINK

In a pub starts for as little as 2 euros but can also be about 4-6 euros in more fancy places.

#### TRAVELING

Is also inexpensive. The price for a train ticket for about two-hour trip is around 10 euros and a flight ticket within Romania starts at 15 euros one-way.

#### FOOD

Is very cheap if you buy it from supermarkets and virtually all accommodations in Romania provide cooking facilities.

Expenses can vary between 400 to 760 euro / month (including accommodation, food, transportation, entertainment).
